Approval based on space availability (limited). Applications (available Feb 1) can be turned in with Kindergarten Registration paperwork.
Curriculum & Assessment	Activities and curriculum are based on children's needs and interests, guided by the district aligned curriculum and EEC Early Learning Standards. Developmentally appropriate assessments given throughout the school year measure how students are growing in key curriculum standards.
School Meals	Free breakfast and lunch are served daily at all schools. Menus are on the website. Federal Free Lunch Program applications are sent home the first day of school. Qualifying students also receive a bus fee waiver if they meet the eligibility for ridership.
Bus Transportation	Available for students attending their zoned school who live 1.5 miles or more away; fees apply, waiver available for qualifying low-income students. Free for K-6 if over 2 miles away. Annual registration required. Applications are available mid-June for the fall, and are mailed to all incoming Kindergarten students and all children enrolled the prior year.

Parents/guardians sign up for 1-hour tours to observe classrooms in action during school hours. Call your school to pre-register; tours are limited to 10 adults each.
SCREENING 4 & 5 Year Olds May-July	Incoming kindergarten students are screened by our Kindergarten teachers and staff to assess a young child's overall developmental skills. Your child will be asked to play some games, draw, and build with blocks. Parents/guardians sign consent to screen forms.
